STOCKHOLDER COMMUNICATIONS POLICY

Effective as of August 1, 2017

Stockholders and other interested parties may communicate directly and confidentially with the Board of Directors, the Non-Management Directors, the Independent Directors, the Presiding Director or the Lead Independent Director by sending a letter addressed to the intended recipients, c/o Corporate Secretary, Venator Materials PLC, 10001 Woodloch Forest Drive, Suite 600, The Woodlands, Texas 77380 or by sending an email specifying the intended recipients to CorporateSecretary@venatorcorp.com. The Corporate Secretary will review such communications and, if appropriate, forward them only to the intended recipients. Communications that do not relate to the responsibilities of the intended recipients as Directors of Venator Materials PLC (such as communications that are commercial or frivolous in nature) will not be forwarded. In addition, communications that appear to be unduly hostile, intimidating, threatening, illegal or similarly inappropriate will not be forwarded. Communications that are not forwarded will be retained by the Corporate Secretary and available for review by the intended recipients upon request.

Any communication received pursuant to this policy that constitutes a report of a possible violation under the Venator Procedures for Handling Reports of Violations of Compliance Program (the "Procedures") will be forwarded to the persons specified in the Procedures in addition to the intended recipients of the communication .

All communications should be accompanied by the following information:

- if the person submitting the communication is a shareholder, a statement of the type and amount of the securities of the Company that the person beneficially owns;
- if the person submitting the communication is not a shareholder and is submitting the communication to the non-management directors as an interested party, the nature of the person's interest in the Company;
- any special interest, meaning an interest not in the capacity of a shareholder of the Company, of the person in the subject matter of the communication; and
- the name, address, telephone number and e-mail address, if any, of the person submitting the communication.
